



# VILLAGE OF MARINE

## PARK REGULATIONS

PARK OPEN 7 A.M. TO DUSK

### PERMITTED USES

- Pavilion or Gazebo may be reserved by Village of Marine residents with a limit of two non-consecutive days per month
- Walking, running, roller-blading, bicycling including electric bicycles, and bicycle trailers, wheelchairs, including motorized wheelchairs
- Picnics in picnic area only and cleaned up after use
- Fishing permitted
- No person shall deposit any trash within the park except in proper receptacles
- Fires in grills only – no open fires allowed
- Extinguish all fires before leaving park
- Leashed pets are permitted but leashes shall be no longer than six feet. Failure to clean up after your pet will result in revocation of this privilege for all. The Village shall have the right to prohibit any pet(s) in the park during special events

### PROHIBITED USES AND ACTIVITIES

- No firearms, bows and arrows, B-B guns, air rifles/pistols allowed
- No fireworks allowed
- No erection of structures or signs
- No metal detectors
- No destruction of park property or littering/no water polluting
- Only authorized vehicles allowed in park
- No boats of any kind
- No motor vehicles, including snowmobiles and ATVs
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs
- No swimming or wading
- No ice skating or skateboarding
- No dumping of any kind including: grass clippings, branches, or yard waste
- No hunting or camping
- No bounce houses

The person reserving the facility is responsible for all damages and clean-up. All lights and fans must be turned off and all decorations removed. Deposit will be required in order to obtain keys no sooner than 48 hours in advance. Keys must be returned within two working days to the Village Hall. Village Hall hours are Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

**PENALTY:** Whoever violates park rules and is convicted of such violation shall be prosecuted. Any infraction of a park rule carries a fine not less than seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars nor more than seven hundred fifty (\$750.00) dollars. (65ILCS Sec. 5/1-2-7; Section 1-1-20; Ord.
